- Summer School is **in-person** at Troy High School as well as on other district campuses. No classes other than health are offered online.
- **Parents and 10-12 grade students will be notified in mid-May via their email address in Aeries** as to what class their student is enrolled in and the location of their class. Some summer school classes will be held at different high schools in the district.
- Summer School class enrollment was conducted with your school counselor during the 2025-26 registration process as well as throughout the spring semester.
- **Spots are limited in summer school. If you would like to add a class that you are not yet enrolled in, see your school counselor during their daily drop-in hours and ask to be placed on the waiting list.**

***NOTE: School Counselors are not on campus after Friday, May 30. If you would like to add a summer school class after that date, you will need to come to the office on Monday, June 2 before 7:30am to check if space is available.**

***NOTE: Both summer school sessions of Drawing/Painting and Troy Tech Geometry must be completed in order to meet the one-year/two-semester requirements.**

Due to the limited number of days during summer school sessions, absences will not be permitted. After a student misses 8 hours of summer school (regardless of the reason), they will be dropped from the class and receive zero credits.

***There are NO excused absences in summer school.**

Health Class Information

All students enrolled in Health will be randomly assigned to a two-week session called a wave.

Wave 1: June 2 - June 12

Wave 2: June 9 - June 18

Wave 3: June 16 - June 26

Wave 4: June 23 - July 3

Wave 5: June 30 - July 10

***Waves 1-5 will be offered to our 10th -12th grade students**

***Waves 3-5 will be open to our incoming 9th grade students as well as our 10th - 12th grade students. *No 9th grade students will be assigned to Waves 1 & 2.**

Due to high demand, we are not able to accommodate requests for a specific wave; students will be assigned randomly, so please **do not** contact the office to request one.

If you would like to “petition” to be enrolled in a different health class wave, please come to the Troy Front Office in person by 7:30 AM on the first day of the health wave you are petitioning; if there are spots available, you will be enrolled at that time.

On their first assigned date of attendance, students will need to report to the Troy High School theater at their designated time. There they will receive a tutorial on how to access the online class and complete the assignments. They will then participate in a short CPR training. After the first day of attendance the Health class will be conducted online.

Incoming 9th grade students will also receive a Chromebook on their first day of Health class which they will keep for the entirety of their time at Troy.

*No student will be issued a chromebook without the Use of Technology Agreement signed, it is available at: <https://www.fjuhsd.org/Domain/1042> . We highly recommend students purchase the chromebook insurance. This can be purchased online the week before the health course and you will receive an email with details.

If you are taking health and an additional summer school class as well, you will receive specific instructions from your health teacher to attend the orientation for health while you are enrolled in your other class. You can let the teacher of your other course know of the date/time of that health orientation so that they are aware.

If you are enrolled in the online Health class and are experiencing issues with your chromebook during summer school, please come to the Troy High School office between 7:30 AM -1:00 PM, Monday through Thursday to see the ed. technician.
