

Cohort Change Request Form

As the data in Orange County continues to improve, Sonora High School will begin its transition to implement the Board approved Hybrid Model. While an official return date has not yet been confirmed, we will continue to monitor and communicate all relevant information with our community. As always, the health and safety of all staff members, students, and families remains our highest priority. Students and parents may now login to the <u>Aeries Parent Portal</u> to view their cohort placement. At this time, requests to move from Cohort A/B to Cohort C, allowing students to continue virtually through distance learning, and respectively, students in Cohort C wishing to move to Cohort A/B, can submit their request using our Cohort Change Request Form. At this time movement between Cohort A to B or B to A is non-optional due to limits regarding state guidelines of student gatherings. You <u>DO NOT</u> need to complete this survey if no changes are needed. Students requesting an alternative <u>MUST</u> complete the <u>Cohort Change Request Form</u> by **September 4, 2020 at 4:00 pm.** Please fill out one form per student per household.
