- D's & F's must be reported via email to all campuses you applied
- Senior year grades matter
- Counselors will **NOT** write appeal letters

1st Semester Grades: D or F

- Must be reported ASAP to all campuses you applied to
- Include: Full Name, Application #
- 1st semester grades will be reported on Mid-Year reports to campuses applied to through CommonAPP

MID YEAR REPORTS & 7TH SEMESTER TRANSCRIPTS

• Mid-Year Reports

- CommonApp: report will be sent automatically by your Counselor
- If school is **NOT** on CommonApp and is requesting midyear report please see your Counselor

• 7th Semester Transcripts

- See your Counselor if a school requests a 7th semester transcript
 - Submit only if campus is requesting
 - May delay your application process if you submit w/out campus requesting

PORTALS:

- ------------ Main source of communication between you and institution
- Activate portal as soon as you receive your credentials

- Student Intent to Register, SIR
- Commit to only one school
 - Deposit may be required
 - Non-refundable
 - Deposit fee varies by Institution

- Waitlists
 - This is the only valid reason to change your mind

- You will receive information regarding next steps to register and deadlines once your application is submitted

- Community Colleges are becoming impacted... APPLY EARLY!!







- Deadline is March 2nd
- Apply: studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa
- Required by all campuses including the Promise Programs at the Community College * Free Tuition for 2 years*

SAR: Student Aid Report

- Summary of what you submitted
- Sent to you and the Colleges AFTER you have submitted your FAFSA
- EFC, Expected Family Contribution is provided

FINAL TRANSCRIPTS

- You may begin to request your final transcript on May 30, 2022

 - Make sure you select Final Transcripts
- It is YOUR responsibility to request your Final Transcripts as they WILL NOT be sent automatically

- May 30th: Request your FINAL TRANSCRIPT
- June 2nd: Graduation!
