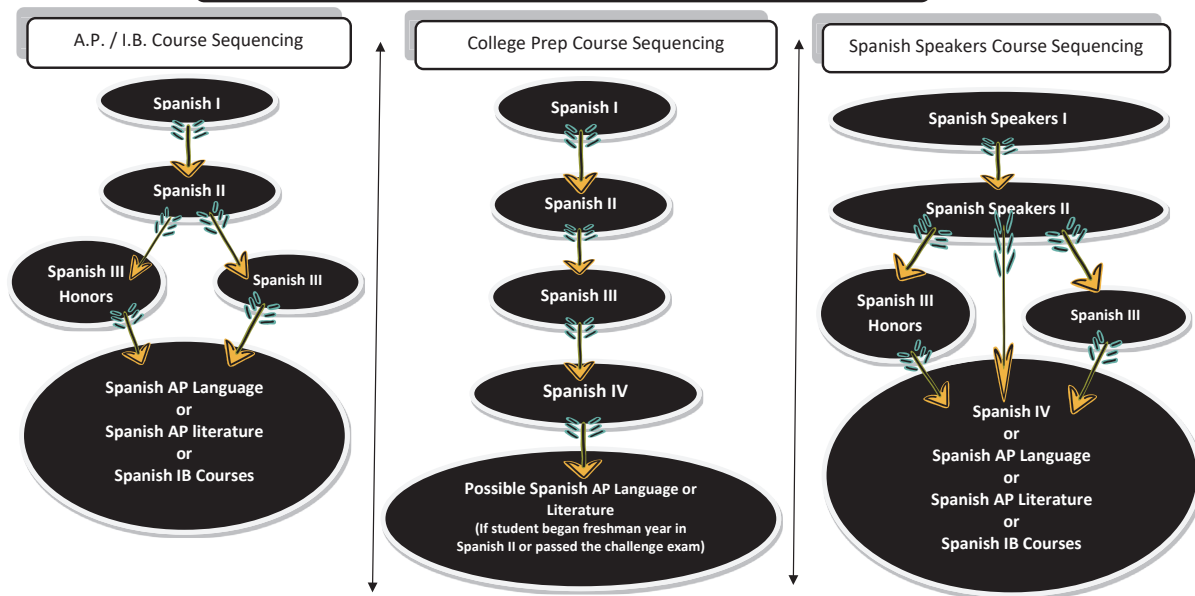
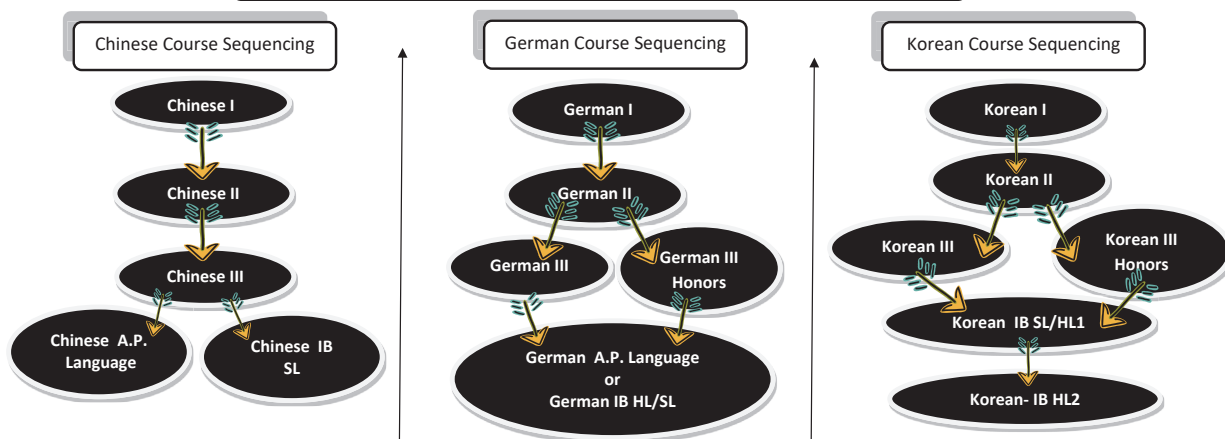


## Spanish Course Offerings and Recommended Sequencing



1. Students are required to get a minimum of a C- or higher in their previous course, semester 2, in order to proceed to the next level of the class.
2. Students who pass Spanish 1 in Junior High are strongly recommended to take the placement test before starting Spanish 2 in their freshmen year.
3. Students wishing to skip a level may opt to take one of our Spanish challenge exams.
4. It is recommended that students have a minimum grade of B+ in Spanish II in order to move to Spanish III Honors.
5. IB classes are for IB diploma candidates only.

## World Language Course Offerings and Recommended Sequencing



1. Students are required to get a minimum of a C- or higher in their previous course, semester 2, in order to proceed to the next level of the class.
1. Students who skip Chinese I may take Chinese I.B.-S.L. after taking A.P. Chinese.
2. Students wishing to skip a level may make an appointment for an individual assessment.
3. It is recommended that students have a minimum grade of B in Chinese III in order to move to A.P./I.B. Chinese.
4. IB classes are for IB diploma candidates only.

1. Students are required to get a minimum of a C- or higher in their previous course, semester 2, in order to proceed to the next level of the class.
2. It is strongly recommended that students earn at least an A or B in German II and have the teacher's recommendation to move on to German III honors due to the natural rigor of the course.
3. It is strongly recommended that students have a minimum grade at least an A or B in German III honors and the teacher's recommendation to move on to AP or IB German.
4. IB classes are for IB diploma candidates only.

1. Students are required to get a minimum of a C- or higher in their previous course, semester 2, in order to proceed to the next level of the class.
2. Incoming **Freshman** may take an entrance exam to skip Korean I and enter directly into Korean II.
3. **Sophomores** who receive an A in in Korean 2 may take our Korean Challenge Exam with the recommendation of their teacher. Those who pass the exam may skip Korean 3 and move directly to Korean IB SL/HL1 and move to Korean IB HL2 the following year.
4. IB classes are for IB diploma candidates only.
