Summary

The Career Interest Profiler helps you find careers by mapping your interests to six basic types of personalities, together called the Holland Code. The higher you score, the more you are like that type.

Consider your education and training aspirations. You have to level up your skills to break into any occupation. Different careers require different certification, licenses, and degrees. 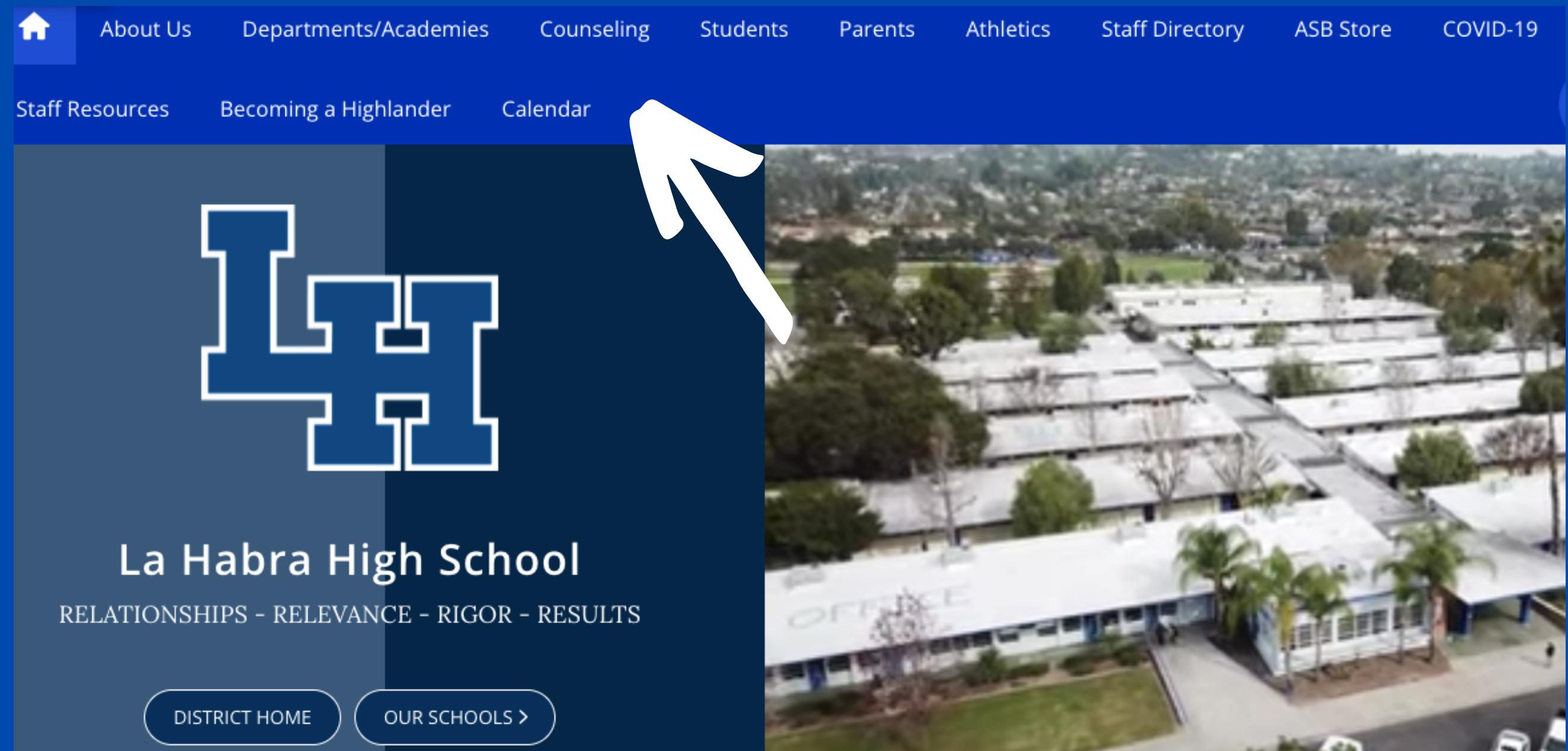

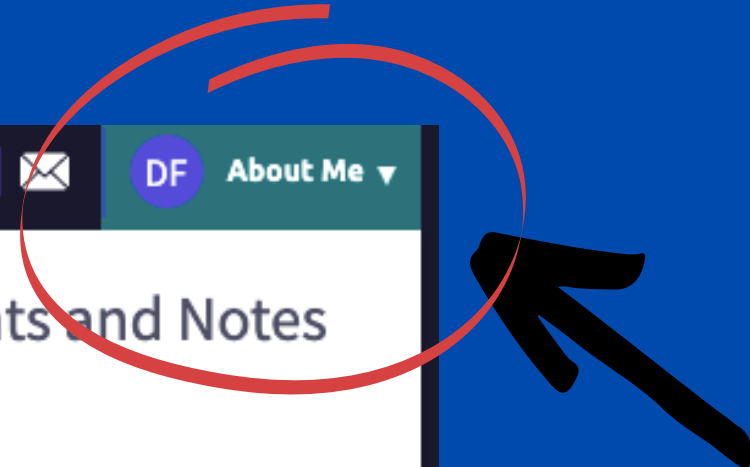

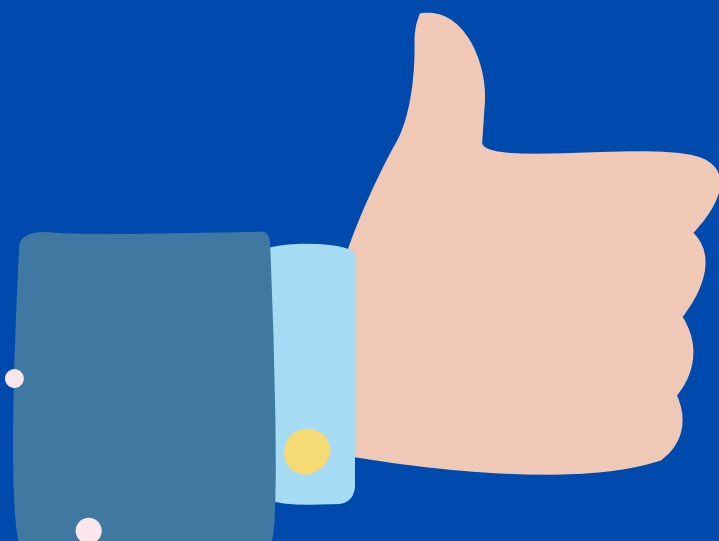
