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COVID STATEMENT

Troy High School is open to all students and staff for a full day of in-person instruction. The 2,554 students attend daily with masks optional and other COVID-19 protection protocols in place.

This year's seniors were impacted over the last three years by COVID-19. However, the 2021-2022 school year saw the grading system was returned to a normal "A-F" grading system with no modification in place.

From 2022-23 on we we're conducting normal school instruction.

To create flexibility, the Troy Tech Senior Interns were able to intern virtually, in person, or with some form of hybrid program. During summer 2024 Internships were both in person (255) and virtual (75) with the remaining students doing a combination of in-person and virtual. A small number of students are presently doing a school year internship.

- 95% of Troy's students attend colleges and universities.
- 4-year colleges and universities **65%** attendance
- 2-year colleges **30%** attendance
- Other (military enlistment, vocational/career college, gap year, entering workforce) 5%
- 79.3%** of the Class of 2024 met the four-year college, A-G entrance requirements for the University of California and the California State University institutions.
- Troy graduates have been accepted to competitive two and four-year colleges and universities throughout our state, nation, and world.

Application process available to academically-talented eighth grade students from across Southern California by math and English-based programs examination.

SCHEDULE AND CURRICULUM

Extended day enrollment with an extra class each semester for four years. Advanced curriculum in technology with pathways focusing on computer science, engineering, cyber defense, media, business, and leadership. AP Computer Science Principles sets the foundation for the pathways. 415 Troy students took the AP CSP exam with a 95% pass rate compared to 65% world-wide.

SENIOR INTERNSHIP: 150 VOLUNTEER HOURS

430 Troy Tech Senior Interns in the 2024 graduating class completed summer or school year internships at 280 business sites or universities with professional mentors in a field of interest. Mentor database of over 1,000 contacts that work with Troy interns locally, nationally, or internationally.
