School Counselor Google Classrooms

For all Troy students, you are already in your school counselor's Google classroom! The classroom title includes your counselor's name and graduating year (i.e., Class of 2023 Ms Saleen). Please check the classroom regularly for announcements, resources and important information.

UC & CSU Applications

Remember that the initial filing period for the UC system application will end on November 30th. The initial filing period for the CSU system application will end this year on December 4th. Don't wait until the last minute to submit your application. The UC and CSU campuses do not want nor require official transcripts or letters of recommendation included with your application. A transcript request will be sent to you when one is needed (or if they would like a recommendation), so be sure to check (and respond to) your email portals often. Links to our

Financial Aid Forms

A reminder to all seniors and their families that they may now file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), California Dream Act Application (CADAA) as well as the CSS Profile (requested by some private institutions). Do not wait to complete these forms, we recommend that you apply now. If you plan to go to college in California, you will want to submit your FAFSA or CADAA before the March deadline in order to qualify for Cal Grants.
