### **FALL 2021 COURSE SCHEDULES**

For incoming freshmen, you may request to change the elective course you registered for at Freshman Orientation on August 6th, provided there is room in the course and parent/guardian approves of the change. All 10-12 graders had the opportunity to adjust requested courses last spring semester. Once the school year starts, students may only request to drop down in course levels (i.e., H/AP/IB to the lower level) if space is available or to drop an additional class. Students in grades 9-11 must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 classes and students in grade 12 must be enrolled in a minimum of 5 classes. Students may drop an additional course by the end of the third week of the fall semester. Students have until the end of the first quarter to drop a course level, space permitting.

## PSAT (PRELIMINARY SAT TEST)/NMSQT (NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFYING TEST)

The PSAT is open to all 10th and 11th graders at Troy and provides practice for the SAT exam.

### ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) EXAM REGISTRATION & PAYMENT THIS FALL

Any students enrolled in AP courses will have the option to take the AP exam for that course in May, 2022. Earning passing AP exam scores may earn you college credit. AP exams will cost approximately \$99.00 each, which includes the registration fee; late registration may have an additional fee. **If a** 

student is enrolled in the Free & Reduced Lunch Program (FRLP), they are eligible for AP exam fee waivers. To apply for the FRLP, you must submit the application at the appropriate station during orientation.
