

Reminder for all Troy High School Students!

In accordance with the Center for Disease Control (CDC), CA Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), and Orange County Health Care Agency (OCHCA), we ask that you complete the Qualtrics survey each morning prior to arriving on campus. However, **please do not attend school** if you have experienced any COVID-related symptoms:

- Flu-like symptoms such as fever of 100.4 or greater
- Chills
- Cough
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose that is not associated with a pre-existing condition or other chronic health condition.

Following the recommendations issued by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has issued guidance in support of full in-person instruction and to as much instructional time as possible. A link to that guidance is included at the bottom of this communication.

Please note that masks will be required by all staff and students while indoors
regardless of vaccinated status. As an extra precaution, FJUHSD is committed to continuing
the enhanced cleaning procedures established to ensure that our schools are clean, sanitized, and
safe. Additionally, using our thermal cameras, temperatures will continue to be taken each
morning.

CDPH COVID-19/K-12-Guidance

Safety Procedures for attending school during the COVID-19 pandemic.

- All students and staff will complete a Qualtrics COVID Safety Survey each morning (the survey will be sent to your school email).
- To enter campus, students will show their green checkmark from the completed survey permitting them to be on campus.
- Students will walk through the thermo-imaging temperature cameras by either the Main Office or the North Gym and show their green Qualtrics survey checkmarks.
- Face coverings (masks) are required inside and are optional while outside.

 Last but not least, <u>if you have taken a COVID-19 test</u> and are still waiting for results, <u>please do not attend school until you receive the results of that test</u>, and then <u>only</u> <u>come to school if you are negative for COVID-19!</u>

Upon arrival, students, staff, and representatives will be required to complete a Qualtrics Survey.

Mr. Varieur served as our school counseling intern last school year and we look forward to him joining our Warrior family."

Students, you should have received an email from the Fullerton Joint Union High School District using our Qualtrics survey asking about your vaccination status. So you are aware, we are asking for this information should we have to contact trace for a positive COVID-19 exposure. Remember, the protocols for a close contact to someone who has tested positive for COVID are far different when a student is vaccinated vs. unvaccinated. Vaccinated students as long as they have no symptoms can go about their regular routine, while unvaccinated students must immediately begin a ten-day quarantine. If you have not yet filled out this specific survey on your vaccination status, please search your school email for the email shown below.

FJUHSD Self-Attestation of COVID-19 Vaccine Status

Fullerton Joint Union High School District (FJUHSD) continues to strive to maintain a School Community that is free from recognized hazards and to promote the health and well-being of our students, their families and our community as a whole. As part of this effort, FJUHSD has implemented certain safety protocols.

At least 80 percent of Californians have received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine. The Pfizer vaccine is fully FDA approved for those 12 years and older.

Getting the COVID-19 vaccine is voluntary for our students, for this inquiry, we are asking you to voluntarily answer the question if you have been "fully vaccinated". Fully vaccinated means that it has been 2 weeks since your final dose, as recommended by the manufacturer, of one of the COVID-19 vaccines.

Are you fully vaccinated (it's been 2 weeks or more after your second dose in a 2-dose series, like the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks or more after a single-dose vaccine, like Johnson & Johnson's vaccine)?


