 - Complete Algebra 1 or equivalent
 - Complete Health
 - This class is only offered in the Summer
 - Pass all required courses

Requirements for 4-Year University

- Course Requirements
 - Must take the required college prep & honors classes for admission - please see the Academic Rubric.
- Academic Grade Requirement
 - Earn competitive grades
 - **NO** "D's" or "F's" are accepted by the 4-year universities for admission
- Test Requirements
 - SAT/ACT is not required for Cal State and UC campuses.
 - Private and Out-of-State Public Universities test policies vary by school

Sunny Hills High School TENTATIVE Summer School Offerings 2025

The Fullerton Joint Union High School District offers two three-week summer sessions for students to make classes and/or advance in a specific subject area. Each three-week session is the equivalent of one semester earning 5 credits. Most courses run five hours per day, Monday through Thursday.

Health	
Health is a 2 week online course that satisfies the Health graduation requirement. Students are required to attend on the first and last day of the term. In between the first and last term, students can either work from home or use the campus computer lab during summer school hours. Summer school runs Monday - Thursday 7:45am - 1:00pm.

Agricultural Pathways

If you have completed Ag. & Soil Chemistry you can either take:

Be mindful of the two year pathway choice to be made at this time
