

ACADEMY OF THE ARTS CHORAL and VOCAL MUSIC PATHWAY

The Choral and Vocal Music Pathway is an opportunity for students to be exposed to an in-depth study and experience in Vocal Music as well as obtain music theory training each semester through coursework and/or performance. This is for students who have an exceptional interest, need, or talent and wish to explore and pursue a degree and/or career in music performance, composition, music education, and/or a lifetime of musical appreciation.

In addition to coursework students must also:

- Complete Academy of the Arts Portfolio in Choral Music each semester
- Take Music Theory AP AND Piano Class
- Be a Member of Tri-M Music Honor Society, in good standing
- Audition for Honor Choirs each year (SCVA/CMEA or other approved) AND **one** of the following, but not limited to:
 - Audition and perform at a Choral/Vocal Concert
 - Be adjudicated at the SCVA Vocal Solo/Small Ensemble Festival
 - Provide visual evidence of participating in a solo studio recital/FUHS Music Showcase
 - Be a part of an outside choral organization

It is also highly suggested that students:

- Attend a music or choral leadership workshop/camp each year
- Receive private instruction in voice all 4 years of high school (some scholarships available)
- Audition and participate in the Spring Musical

This Pathway Meets the FJUHS Admissions Requirements, CSU Admissions Requirements, and the minimum UC Admissions Requirements. Students must maintain a minimum of 3.0 cumulative GPA, including in all required arts courses.

This Pathway requires students to take four years of Choral music courses, plus a minimum of one year additional of Piano AND Music Theory AP. (For students who would like to test out of this requirement, they are able to on request. Please speak with the instructor.)
