



ACADEMY OF THE ARTS INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PATHWAY



The Instrumental Music Pathway is an opportunity for students to be exposed to an in-depth study and experience of instrumental music on their respective instrument as well as obtain music theory training each semester through coursework and/or performance. This is for students who have an exceptional interest or desire to explore and pursue a degree and/or career in music performance, composition, music education, and/or a lifetime of musical appreciation.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC PATHWAY: This Pathway Meets the FJUHSD Admissions Requirements, CSU Admissions Requirements, and the UC Admissions Requirements. Students must maintain a minimum of 3.0 in all required arts courses.

In addition to coursework students must also:

- Complete Academy of the Arts Portfolio in Inst. Music
- Become a Member of Tri-M Music Honor Society
- Audition for Honor Band each year (SCSBOA or other approved)
- Letter in Inst. Music Program (3.0 Cumulative GPA by Junior Year)
- Perform a solo or in a small ensemble at Winter and Spring Concerts in 11th and 12th grade

It is also highly suggested that students:

- Attend a music workshop/camp each year
- Receive private instruction on their instrument all 4 years of high school
- Perform as part of the Pit Orchestra for the Spring Musical
- Hold a leadership position in Inst. Music Program
