- Mon, 5/13 SENIOR AWARDS PROGRAM (6:00-8:00 p.m.) PLUMMER AUDITORIUM Senior Awards will be held at Plummer Auditorium in Fullerton from 6:00-8:00 p.m. Seniors should arrive by 5:45 p.m. Caps and gowns will NOT be worn. All family members and friends are invited to attend. No tickets are necessary.
- Wed. & Thurs. YEARBOOK DISTRIBUTION (Tutorial, Break and Lunch) ACTIVITIES WINDOWS We expect to hand out yearbooks sometime during this time period. Yearbooks will be given to seniors who have ASB cards first and then all other seniors after that. You must have your current I.D. card to pick up your yearbook and have no fines. Seniors with fines may pick up their yearbook on May 30<sup>th</sup> at 12:20 p.m.
- \*\*CAP & GOWN DISTRIBUTION (Tutorial, Break & Lunch) WRESTLING ROOM Seniors will pick up cap and gown packages at tutorial, break, and lunch on this day. All packages will be distributed by SoCalGrad. Please see the reverse side of this timeline for additional information. \*\*
- \*SENIOR ACTIVITY/BREAKFAST (8:04 a.m.-12:20 p.m.) All members of the senior class are invited to participate in a senior activity at Dave and Busters. Seniors will be bussed to and from the event. There is no charge for the activity. Seniors who choose not to attend this event will be required to go to their regular classes for the day. Seniors going to the activity will meet in the gym at the beginning of the school day (8:04 a.m.) to check in. Seniors not going to this event will not report to the gym but will report to their regular classes as scheduled.
- \*SENIOR DAY/PRIOR to REHEARSAL (8:04-9:00 a.m.) GYM Join your class for a "light" breakfast prior to graduation rehearsal at La Habra HS. There is no charge to attend. Senior Wills will be distributed at this time. Seniors will be bussed to and from graduation rehearsal at LHHS. Mandatory Attendance!
- \*GRADUATION REHEARSAL (10:00 a.m.-12:30 p.m.) LHHS STADIUM Seniors are required to attend graduation rehearsal at 10:00 a.m. All seniors must ride the bus to and from rehearsal. When you get off the bus, you will line up on the blacktop in back of the bleachers. You will be given a final marching list at the rehearsal. Mandatory Attendance!
- Thurs. 5/30 #GRADUATION LHHS STADIUM (6:30 p.m.) Seniors and participating staff will line up on the blacktop behind the stadium bleachers at 5:30 p.m. at LHHS Stadium. Bring your cap, gown, and tassel (don't wear them). You will put them on after you have been searched and admitted to the staging area. The graduation processional begins promptly at 6:30 p.m. Make sure you pick up your diploma immediately after graduation in the theater.

\*Please Note: These events are mandatory for all seniors. They are part of the regular school day. You must attend! As a reminder, school will be in session from 8:04 a.m. until 12:20 p.m. on 5/28/19, 5/29/19, and 5/30/19. All seniors are expected to attend their classes or the scheduled activity.

## **Additional Cap & Gown Information**

\*\*Cap and gown packages will be distributed to seniors who have met the requirements for graduation and have no fine holds. Seniors who are eligible to pick up their cap and gown package will receive their cap, gown, tassel, and graduation tickets in the package. If a senior does not graduate, they will <u>not</u> be eligible to receive tickets to the graduation ceremony, and the cost of the cap and gown package will be refunded to them if they have paid for it. Cap and gown packages will be distributed in the Wrestling Room during tutorial, break and lunch on Tuesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>. Beginning May 22<sup>nd</sup>, cap and gown packages will be held in the main office. You may pick them up at the Activities window at tutorial, break, or lunch. Please make sure you pick up your package on May 21<sup>st</sup> if you are not on hold.
