CSF Membership Information Packet

(Updated November 2021)

CSF is an academic service club, but students must apply to join. Whereas the CSF membership criteria never change, students' grades do. Therefore, it is necessary for students to apply regularly--and specifically, each time their grades change, that is, each semester. Eligibility is determined by the applicant's grades earned in the semester just completed. The final date for a student to submit his or her application each semester will never exceed four weeks after the beginning of the semester.

ENROLLMENT PERIOD AND MEMBERSHIP LEVELS

Students must complete and submit a CSF application during the specified enrollment period each semester.

Life Membership is awarded to those graduating seniors who have qualified four semesters out of the possible six semesters in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades. One of the qualifying semesters must be earned in the senior year.

100% Membership is awarded to graduating seniors who have qualified all six semesters in the 10th, 11th, and 12th grades.

Associate Membership is awarded to those students who become eligible after having completed the first semester of 9th grade at Troy High School and to Honor Members of the CJSF in junior high school.

Requirements for CSF Membership

Only FIVE classes totaling a maximum of 17 points may be used to qualify a student for CSF membership in any one semester. All five classes may come from List I or the five may be distributed as follows:

- 1 From Lists I and II together, a student must take a minimum of 3 classes (2 of which must come from List I) and earn 7 points (4 of which must come from List I); and from List III, a student may take a maximum of 2 classes and earn 3 points.
- 2 A student must earn a minimum of 10 CSF points in a semester. In a five-unit semester course, points are earned on the basis of this CSF formula: in college preparatory classes, 3 points are awarded for an "A" and 1 point for a "B"; in Honors, AP and IB classes, 4 points are awarded for an "A" and 2 points for a "B". Note: only two classes may be used to earn points in Honors, AP, and IB classes.
- 3 Only second semester seniors may use at least 3 List II courses in lieu of any List I course when tallying their CSF points.
- 4 A grade of "D" or "F" in any class or a "U" in citizenship will automatically disqualify an applicant for the semester only. Students are encouraged to apply again in following semesters.
- 5 Students may not transfer CSF points from one semester to another.

You may calculate your eligibility below. This information must be complete and accurate for you to qualify for membership in the Troy High School Chapter 786s of the California Scholarship Federation.

A minimum of ten points will be required to qualify.
