Dear La Vista High School Parents and Students,

I hope this letter finds you and your families safe and well. We wish to use this opportunity to provide information regarding summer school to our students and families. With the Covid-19 school closures still in place, distance learning will continue during summer school. All La Vista High School students will be enrolled in the summer school distance learning program. Summer school will begin on June 1, 2020 through June 25, 2020. Classes will be online from 8:00am until 1:00pm, Monday through Thursday. Each student will be enrolled in two courses during the summer program. Their first class will run from 8am until 10:20 am and the second class will run from 10:35am until 1:00pm. As our La Vista students are working to recover and earn credit, enrollment in the two courses and the possible 10 credits can help them get back on track to meet graduation requirements.

As a requirement of the summer school program, each student will need to attend and participate in each class everyday. Teachers will take attendance for each class at the beginning of and at just prior to the end of each period. Students are expected to log into their online Google Classroom at 8:00am and 10:20 am for their first class and again at 10:30 and 12:50 for their second class. Attendance is critical for student success and students may be dropped if they miss more than two days in each class..

As a reminder, all La Vista High School students will be enrolled in summer school. If you do not want your student to attend our summer program, please contact the appropriate school counselor through one of the following options by May 14, 2020:
