

Interventions for Students Not Wearing a Mask **Not Maintaining Proper Social Distancing**

Administration will investigate to determine if student action is an act of defiance or if it is an accident. If defiance, proceed with the following steps:

First offense:

- The student will be warned and reminded of the rule and offered a mask and/or instructed to appropriately social distance.
- The Teacher or Administrator will document the incident in Aeries Pre-Intervention notes and Discipline Record.
- If the student refuses to comply with the rule(s) he/she will be moved to Cohort C.

Second offense:

- The student will be warned and reminded of the rule(s) and offered a mask and/or instructed to appropriately social distance.
- The Teacher or Administrator will document the incident in Aeries Pre-Intervention notes and Discipline Record.
- The student's parents/guardians will be contacted and the student and their parent/Guardian will be notified that upon a 3rd offence, the student will be moved to Cohort C.
- If the student refuses to comply with the rule they will be moved to Cohort C.

Third offense:

- The parents/guardians are notified and the student is placed in Cohort C effective immediately and the student will continue the school day in a designated and supervised location on the school site for the remainder of the day.
- Administrator will document the incident in Aeries Pre-Intervention notes and Discipline Record.

Re-Entry:

- Students are allowed to apply for re-entry upon completion of no less than two (2) weeks in Cohort C by written request. Application letters will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
