## Scholarship Eligibility:

- 1. Be a female African American high school senior residing in <u>or</u> attending high school in Orange County.
- 2. Minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- 3. Acceptance to an accredited 4-year college or university for the fall of 2023
- 4. **Demonstrated exceptional leadership** through community service and/or involvement in extracurricular activities

## **Scholarship Application Requirements:**

- Copy of signed transcript submitted by a high school counselor or with the high school seal
- An essay of 400 600 words with prompt:
  What are the influences that social media or other news sources have on the social justice movement?
- Two letters of recommendation on official letterhead (Relatives and Peers may not submit) to https://akameo.org/scholarship/
  - One letter from a teacher, counselor, employment supervisor, or coach
  - One letter from a person who can attest to your personal character and attributes

The deadline for submitting required scholarship applications and attachments including (2) letters of recommendations is **Monday**, **April 3**, **2023**.
