Course Title: Naval Science - 2 (NJROTC 2)

Course Prerequisites: Refer to annual registration presentation

Course Description:

Naval Science 2: Cadets are introduced to sea power and national security, naval operations and support functions, military law, international law and the sea, basic seamanship, ship construction, and damage control. Drills, command, ceremonies, and special events are used as a practical application of cadet leadership training. Cadets are assigned high level positions of leadership and responsibility within the cadet corps. Cadets are expected to complete the reading assignments in advance and complete the assigned homework. Homework will be legibly printed, including your name, and turned in at the beginning of class unless otherwise directed.
