Course Profile

Course Title: Spanish 3 IB-SL

Course Prerequisites: Refer to annual registration presentation

Course Description: This course is designed to provide the student with the opportunity to continue to develop Spanish language skills (reading, listening, speaking, and writing) and hispanic cultural awareness acquired from the novice level courses within the context of the IB themes. Activities such as applied language/cultural projects and IB text type writing assignments will enhance the students abilities to perform at an intermediate/advanced level.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

Recognition and application of vocabulary/expressions learned at the novice level courses (Spanish 1 and Spanish 2) as well as application of foundational/basic Spanish language skills and structures such as conjugating verbs accordingly and use of correct syntax in writing and speaking.

Workload expectations for this course:

Daily practice of vocabulary and grammar is expected. Homework includes vocabulary and grammar practice activities/ exercises as well as reviewing reading passages. Homework may require 10-20 minutes of the student's time outside of class. Projects may require more than 20 minutes to complete outside of class depending on the nature of the assignment and group collaboration with classmates if necessary.
