Course Title: Spanish 2

Course Prerequisites: Refer to annual registration presentation

Course Description: Spanish 2 continues to build on the communication skills learned in Spanish 1. The student continues to develop vocabulary skills and uses increasingly complex language structures in listening, speaking, reading, and writing activities. The exploration of the cultures and history of Spanish-speaking countries continues.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills: Spanish 1 vocabulary topics; present tense of regular, irregular and stem changing verbs; subject and object pronouns; noun, adjective and subject/verb agreement; number/gender; definite/indefinite articles; basic sentence formation; expressions with tener; the verb gustar

Workload expectations for this course: active in-class participation; daily classwork and light homework most days of the week; quizzes, tests and cultural projects per chapter; five minute daily review outside of class
