Sports Broadcasting 1 Honors

Course Prerequisites:

Course Description:

The content of the course is in three distinct parts:

- Production to employ the professional studio and its equipment to broadcast live sporting events. Various roles include: technical director, sound engineer, cameraperson, prompter, score, graphics, replay, commentator, director, etc.
- 2. **Curricular** lessons and projects that will increase the students ability to tell compelling stories from our athletic community. Content includes: event broadcasting, editing skills, interview skills, graphics creation, camera usage, social media content creation, commercials, editing, etc.
