Troy High School Course Profile

Course Title: Naval Science 4, Naval Junior Reserve Training Corps Honors

Course Prerequisites: Cadets must be a 12th grade student at Troy High School. Cadets must have received at least an 80% in Naval Science 3 to qualify for NS4 Honors. Cadets must be recommended by the current Naval Science 3 Instructor. Cadets may be accepted on a case-by-case basis by the Senior Naval Science Instructor.

Course Description: The course will primarily consist of Leadership and Ethics studies. The cadets will be given many opportunities to organize and manage various unit events throughout the school year. Cadets will also be held to the highest standard in regards to Physical Fitness, Uniform Inspection, and program knowledge. There will be weekly physical fitness homework and group projects throughout the year. The intent is to prepare cadets for success after graduation by building their confidence and skills in social interaction.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills: Cadets should have reached the rank of Cadet Second Class Petty Officer. They should also have a strong understanding of proper uniform wear and expectations in regards to participation. NS4 Cadets will not be allowed to be "50 minute cadets". These are cadets that only attend the class and do not participate.

Workload expectations for this course: NS4's will be expected to be involved with activities outside of the normal class period. NJROTC teams, Troy Clubs, Troy Athletics, Troy Activities, community service, unit service, and school service will be expected by those cadets in the NS4 Honor's Course. Cadets will learn all regulation drill by the end of the school year. Cadets will either pass the end of year Physical Fitness Assessment or will show significant improvement. NS4 Cadets will be expected to have a 3.0 G.P.A. to remain in the program. Cadets will perform Physical Training 5 days a week including the

normal Physical Training days. NS4 cadets will not only be the best cadets in the Troy NJROTC, but will set the example for the entire Senior Class.
