Course Title:
Show Choir

Course Prerequisites:
No prior musical experience is required.

Course Description:
Show Choir is a mixed choir open to all students. No previous vocal experience is required. The group offers the opportunity to study and perform a variety of music and musical styles. The group performs in school concerts and also represents Troy High School in festivals and other events. The class focuses on vocal production and performance techniques, breath support, choreography, stamina, music reading, performance skills. Students receive P.E and Fine Arts credit.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

- Ability to maintain an accurate schedule of commitments
- Desire to prepare a variety of styles of music for performance

Workload expectations for this course:
Show Choir members will have a significant amount of music to prepare, memorize, and master. The group performs in four school concerts per year as well as in choral festivals and other events as scheduled.
