

## **Troy High School Course Profile**

### **Course Title:**

Show Choir - Advanced Treble (“Ladies First”)

### **Course Prerequisites:**

Audition

### **Course Description:**

“Ladies First” is an advanced choir of female singers, performing a variety of styles of music for concerts, festivals, and other events. The group functions as a traditional women’s choir and as a competitive show choir. The class focuses on vocal production and performance techniques, breath support, choreography, stamina, music reading, performance skills. Students receive P.E and Fine Arts credit.

### **Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:**

- Ability to read music at an intermediate to advanced level
- Experience in choral singing
- Ability to prepare and memorize a large amount of music for performance
- Ability to sing with one singer on each part (soprano, mezzo, alto 1, alto 2)
- Ability to learn and perform choreography
- Ability to maintain an accurate schedule of commitments

### **Workload expectations for this course:**

“Ladies First” members will have a significant amount of music and choreography to prepare, memorize, and master. There are frequent performances, rehearsals, competitions, and other events.
