Course Description:

Empowering Entrepreneurs Honors is an innovative course that helps equip students for professional success in a variety of industries and roles. Students learn core business principles and analyze modern workplace trends, through the lens of entrepreneurship and business development. Areas of study include business planning, financial management, product development, marketing, and more. The course emphasizes communication, creative problem–solving, and the integration of technology and digital tools. The students apply their learning via collaborative real–world activities and analysis of entrepreneurs, successful startups, and small businesses. The course culminates with each student creating their own "business on paper." The course content is aligned with Common Core and Career Technical Education standards, and it provides an excellent foundation for future business studies.

Workload expectations for this course:

Honors-level. Most assignments can be completed in class, though if the work is not finished then, it becomes homework. There is one research project each semester, in addition to frequent work on the student's "business on paper." There are standard honors-level assessments at regular intervals, with class
