- ♦ 2,700 students – 693 seniors in the Class of 2018
- ♦ Located next to California State University, Fullerton, offering unique, high-level educational opportunities to Troy's students
- ♦ Academic day: 57 minutes/class, 5 days/week, 180 days/year
- ♦ Orange County's highest comprehensive high school Academic Performance Index 2013 - 937/1000
- ♦ Diverse demographics:
