## SCHOOL SCHEDULE

The school year includes two semesters of approximately eighteen weeks. Each semester is comprised of two quarters. Students receive two sets of official grades, recorded at the end of each semester, December and May. Each day is divided into six 53 minute periods. Seven periods are available to students.

## 2019/20 SCHOOL YEAR COVID-19 MODIFICATIONS

FUHS transitioned to full time distance learning on March 16, 2020 and remained on distance learning through the end of the school year. Students were required to check into their classes daily. The grading scale was adjusted to accommodate for the abrupt change to the schedule. Any grade of 69% through 55% was recorded as a C-. Any grade below a 55% was recorded as an "NC" - No Credit.

## GRADING

### GRADING:

Grade point averages are computed on a four point scale with A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1 and F=0. Grades are weighted for Honors, International Baccalaureate and Advanced Placement classes with A=5, B=4, and C=3. Courses earning extra grade points are designated with a "+" preceding the course title.

CLASS RANK: All classes are included in computing the grade point average.

## ACADEMY PROGRAMS

**Agri-Science Academy** offers two pathways, Plant Sciences and Animal Sciences. Plant Science students study Sustainable Ag Biology, Chemistry in Ag, Advanced Plant Science, and Ag Leadership. Animal Science students study Sustainable Ag Biology, Veterinary Science, Advanced Animal Science, and Ag Leadership.

**Academy of the Arts** can be completed through Visual or Performing Arts. The Visual Arts program offers digital and film photography, traditional drawing and painting, 3-D design, and the digital arts. Gallery 208, located on campus, provides professional space to showcase student and alumni work.

FUHS is one of the first high schools to offer a Triple Threat program (Dance, Theater, and Vocal Performance). Our performing arts students attend numerous festivals and are often invited to perform with industry professionals.

Instrumental music serves all students. Entry level students can enroll in guitar or piano and those advanced musicians can become part of our marching band or jazz ensemble.

**Culinary Academy** students take 4 years of Culinary to complete the academy and can graduate with their ProStart certificate granting them immediate access to industry work.

**JROTC** program earned the Honor Unit with Distinction for its 12th straight year and is ranked in the top 1% of the programs in the nation.

**Speech & Debate** Four time National Champions 2008, 2010, 2013, 2014, California state champions in 2011. 100% of the Speech & Debate graduates go to college, 90% earn a scholarship.

**BEAST Academy** is the only program of its kind, integrating Biology-Engineering-Arts-Science-Technology. It is a 2 year program where students imagine, design, & create "creature characters" using the skills of an artist, the understanding of a biologist, and the methods of an engineer.
