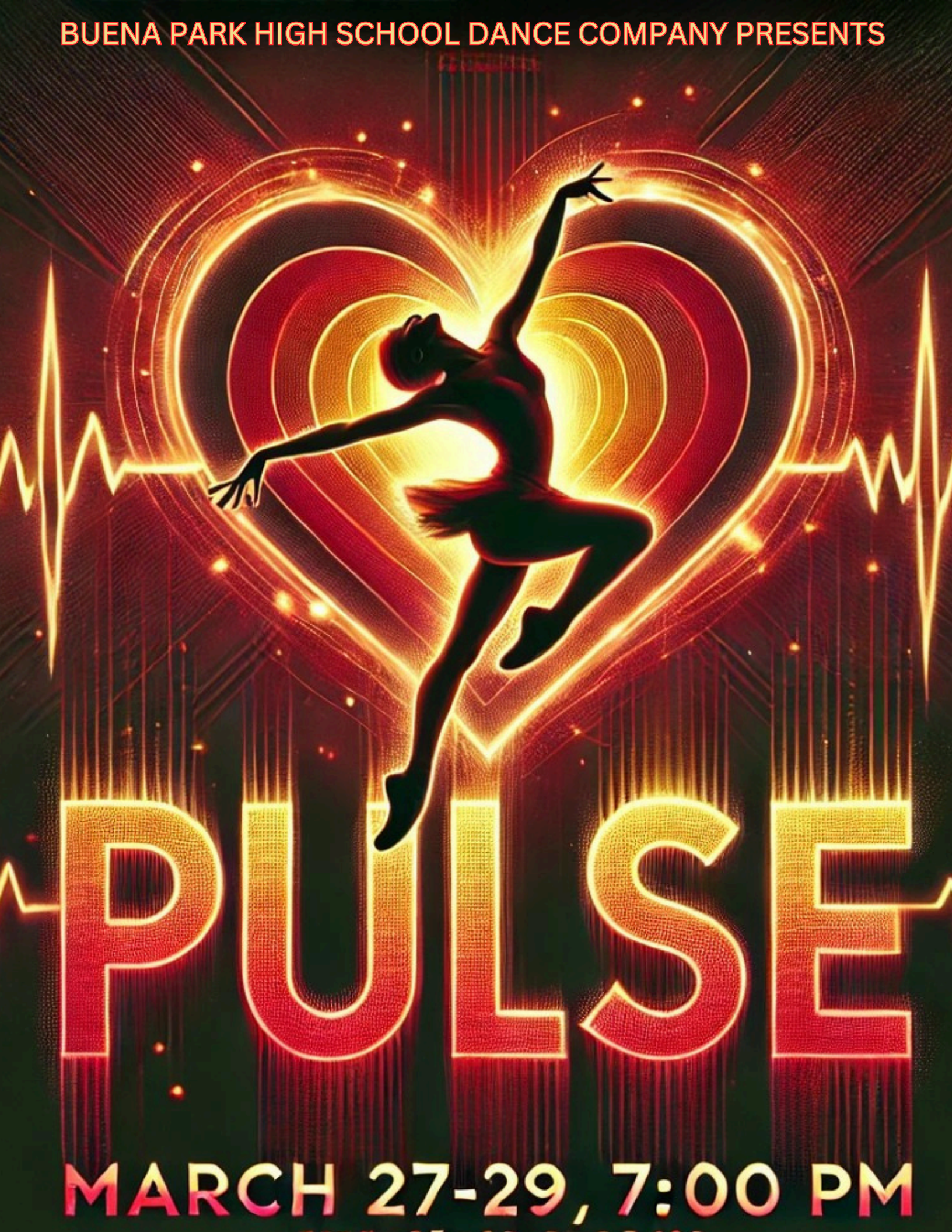

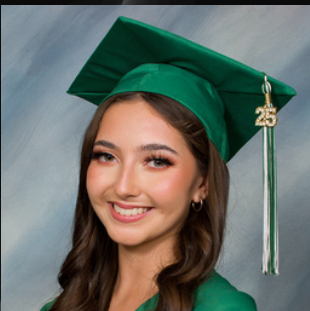

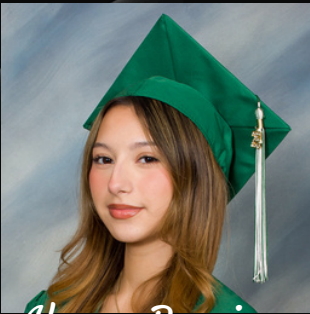
Alyssa Moreno-Montes
