2018/19 Math Curriculum Adoption

Adoption Process (Updated February 2019)

Foundations, Algebra 1, Geometry and Algebra 2 courses are piloting new instructional resources between August, 2018 and March, 2019. The first resource is *Agile Mind*, the second is *Math Techbook Discovery Education*, and the third is *enVision A/G/A Pearson* (added February 2019). All three curriculum have been independently verified to meet the highest levels of mathematical content (Common Core) and pedagogy (how math is taught) by EdReports.org. The process will culminate in the recommendation of math instructional materials that will be implemented beginning in the fall of 2019/20.

- Analysis of both curriculum based on New Essential Features list
- Committee removed Agile Mind from pilot
- Committee added enVision A/G/A Pearson to pilot

March, 2019

- Select math curriculum to recommend to Board for adoption

April - May, 2019

- Curriculum available for community investigation
