FULLERTON JOINT UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT HOLDS GROUNDBREAKING FOR EIGHTH KEY MEASURE I PROJECT, LA HABRA HIGH SCHOOL NEW PERFORMING ARTS CENTER AND REMODEL OF STADIUM PROJECT

The Fullerton Joint Union High School District (FJUHSD) held a public groundbreaking ceremony for the new performing arts center and remodel of stadium at La Habra High School located at 801 W Highlander Avenue, La Habra, on Wednesday, January 10, 2018 at 12:15 p.m. The new performing arts center is the eighth official project to break ground under the current \$175 million, voter-approved Measure I bond program and remodel of stadiums.

The all new Performing Arts Center (PAC) will be 24,981 square feet of beautiful space containing 14,600 square feet of theatre space with seating for 623 guests. The theatre will house all new curtains, lights, audio/visual equipment, orchestra pit, cat walks, and cloud. The remaining 10,400 square feet will include new restrooms, dressing rooms, storage, workroom and scene shop, green room, and a black box theatre. The PAC will include exterior site work, a loading dock, a modern storefront, and lobby with windows.



The stadium remodel is substantial. The athletic field will be enlarged and fitted with a new 95,000 square foot synthetic turf field for soccer and football. The stadium will be turned around to allow for the current home side to become the visitor side and the old visitor side is to be completely remodeled to include new home bleachers and a press box. There will be a total of 7,000 seating capacity. There will be new scoreboards, 4,340 square foot concession and restroom building and a re-surfacing of the tennis courts. Construction will take 18 months with a completion date of July 2019.

“This is the eighth of many outstanding projects that will serve our students for the next 50 years,” said Superintendent Scott Scambray of Fullerton Joint Union High School District.

The next phase of high-priority Measure I projects the District is scheduled to kick off is the gym modernization at La Habra High School; new stadium at Buena Park High School; and new theatre at Buena Park High School.
