Location & Weather


Ask yourself?

 - Consider a virtual visit to a UC campus with a cooler climate (ex. UCSC, UCB)








Majors and Minors

UC Reputation






ACADEMIC

COST

- Scholarships, Grants, Work-Study
 - Blue and Gold Opportunity Plan
 - Chancellors, Regents Scholarships, Alumni Scholarships, etc.
- 57% of Undergraduates attend tuition FREE
- 72% receive Grants & Scholarships
- 42% graduate with NO student loan debt!
- What is the approximate cost of living in the area?
- UC tuition is approx. \$13,500
- Total Cost of Attendance approx. \$35,000

 - FREE support with housing, financial aid, etc.
 - Summer programs –at UCLA it's Freshman Summer Program

- Learn a new language


