- We have a limited number of lockers available. If you would like to have a locker and you have no fines; you have your Emergency Card, Technology Use form, and your Insurance form turned in or have it to turn in, please come to the Activities window at break or lunch. If you have a locker, make sure you keep a lock on it at all times. If you do not keep a lock on your locker, we will take it away from you and register it to someone on the waiting list. If you need to have your locker repaired or have a lock cut, please see Mrs. Vorell at the Activities window at break or lunch only.

- If you did not attend orientation and you need to buy an ASB Card, yearbook, parking permit, or class sweatshirt, you may do so at the Activities windows at break or lunch. There are also a limited number of packages still available for \$135.00. You can pay with cash, check, or credit card. - If you are a student and drive a car to school, you must park it in the student parking lot, and you must have a blue 2017-18 parking permit displayed on the rear-view mirror of your car. Pick up a parking permit request form prior to purchasing your permit at the Activities window. Bring your I.D. card, driver's license, completed parking permit form, and money, if applicable, to the Activities window at break or lunch to obtain your parking permit. Remember, any car without a current parking permit will be ticketed by the La Habra Police Department. Ticketing will begin next week, so make sure you get your permit as soon as possible. Make sure you are legally parked in the student parking lot and have a current student parking permit on your vehicle.

Our JROTC program at Sonora High School is an Honor Unit with Distinction and is a National Military Honor Society. Cadets can earn a graduation cord by being in JROTC for four years and you can also earn a JROTC Varsity Letter by being on one of our JROTC teams including Color Guard, Armed or Unarmed Drill Team, or Raider Team. There is no obligation to join the military if you are in JROTC, but if you are interested in serving in the Military and take two years of JROTC you can enlist in the Military at one pay grade higher, which is a significant pay increase. JROTC can also assist those interested in obtaining ROTC scholarships and Military Academy Appointments. If you are interested in JROTC, see Colonel Hunt in Room 303.</li> </ul>
