Question	Answer
What needs to be done for a student to receive their Chromebook?	Visit the La Habra High School (LHHS) website ( <a href="www.lahabrahighschool.net">www.lahabrahighschool.net</a> ) and go to <i>Students</i> drop down and select <i>Chromebooks</i> for detailed instructions and all necessary documents. Forms can also be found in the Main Office (room 12).
What if a student damages or loses their Chromebook?	The student is liable for any loss or damage that occurs (same as a textbook). The replacement cost for the Chromebook is \$350. Chromebook insurance is available through the Fullerton Joint Union High School District (FJUHSD) for \$25. If your student qualifies for Free and Reduced Lunch, the amount is \$10. Additional information regarding Chromebook insurance is also available on the LHHS website.
Does a student have to check out a Chromebook? Can't they just leave it at school and pick it up every day?	A student does not have to check out a Chromebook. However, as with a textbook, the Chromebook will be essential for LHHS educational programs. We encourage parents to look into the insurance options if they are concerned about liability. A student picking up a Chromebook at the beginning of the day and turning it back in at the end would still be liable for anything that happens during the school day. Additionally, LHHS does not have the capability to overnight charge and secure large quantities of laptops.
Can a student use their personal laptop?	We encourage students to use the school issued Chromebook. If parents or student insist on bringing in their own device, LHHS will not install any software on the device. If any specific software is required for the class, it is the responsibility of the student to load the software to their personal device. Issues with personal computers will not be supported by LHHS or FJUSHD personnel.
What precautions should students take to avoid theft?	Students should never leave their Chromebook unattended or transport it without it being safely stored. The Chromebook should remain concealed in the Chromebook case if provided, backpack, or other suitable bag any time it is not in use.
Can other family members use the Chromebook?	The Chromebook is for student use only. Parents may use the Chromebook to access the Aeries Parent Portal to check student information and grades. The student is liable for all activity that takes place on the Chromebook.
What will the Chromebooks be used for?	Chromebooks will be used for a variety of educational purposes including, but not limited to: web based research, discussion boards, access to assignments, assessments (tests/quizzes), project based learning, development of documents, spreadsheets, and presentations.
When will the Chromebook be returned?	Chromebooks will be returned at the end of the student's senior year along with the issued charger and any peripherals, and they must be fully charged. Chromebooks will be carefully screened prior to return to ensure each device is not damaged and in working order.
