



Top 10 Things NOT To Do with Your Chromebook

- 1. Do **NOT** personalize your Chromebook. No Exceptions. Leave it the way you received it.
- 2. Do **NOT** use your Chromebook while eating or drinking.
- 3. Do **NOT** close your Chromebook with foreign object(s) inside (e.g. pen, pencil, etc.)
- 4. Do **NOT** try to fix your Chromebook yourself. This includes taking it to any repair shop. If you have any issues with your Chromebook, please take it to the library.
- 5. Do **NOT** share your password with anyone.
- 6. Do **NOT** forget your Chromebook & charger at home. Chromebook must be fully charged everyday before school.
- 7. Do **NOT** attempt to access inappropriate material online. This includes trying to bypass District filters and firewalls to access websites otherwise restricted/blocked by FJUHSD.
- 8. Do **NOT** exchange Chromebook with anyone. Students are assigned Chromebooks based on the barcode that is located on top of your Chromebook. **Please memorize your Chromebook barcode**.
- 9. Do **NOT** hold/carry Chromebook by the screen.
- 10. Do **NOT** forget to buy insurance. Otherwise you'll be responsible for the full cost of **repairs of up to \$350** which includes replacing the device.

Final Notes:

- Personalizing your Chromebook may result in a fine!
- Chromebook must be cleaned/wiped down, free of dirt, stains, stickers/adhesives, etc. before checking it back in to LHHS.
- You are responsible for the Chromebook checked out to you. If someone else damages your Chromebook, you will be responsible for any damage fees. <u>Please take care of</u> your Chromebook!
