FULLERTON COLLEGE DSS STUDENT SUCCESS TIPS

CHOOSING INSTRUCTORS & BUILDING YOUR CLASS SCHEDULE

- Use ratemyprofessor.com to read reviews about instructors.
- Avoid taking early morning or late evening classes if those are not the times you are usually ready to learn.
- Plan breaks between classes to allow for tutoring sessions and accommodations like extended testing time.
- Consider taking less than 12 units, especially in your first semester.
- Avoid taking Math and English during the same semester.
- Enroll in a Counseling class your first semester.
- Consider enrolling in the Adaptive Computer Lab.
- Avoid online classes if possible. Consider Zoom options and/or on-campus classes when available.

- The Extended Opportunity Program & Services (EOPS) program has extended the deadline to apply for the Spring 22 semester to Thursday, February 17, 2022.
- High School students planning to attend Fullerton College for the Fall 2022 semester can begin to apply to our program starting Monday, April 4, 2022.
 - We encourage all high school students seniors to apply sooner to our program to take advantage of our priority registration perk!
 - Once you apply to our program, your application will approximately take two weeks to process.

 - First-generation college student
 - Underrepresented student population
 - Current or Former Foster Youth




