- A minimum of 217.5 credits
- 40 credits earned this school year
- Enrolled in 5 classes this school year
- Pass Algebra 1 or equivalent
- Completed Senior Survey and Financial Aid Form
- Appropriate behavior and conduct at school and at all SHHS events until graduation.
- Complete the CPR Requirement

Mandatory Attendance

- Arrive on time so we can finish on time
- Report to the FUHS GYM & find your row
- Everyone will be assigned to a teacher
- Seating assignments will be posted on Tues May 27
- Those who do not attend will not participate in the Graduation ceremony
- Plan on heavy traffic; leave home early and carpool with other students
- Parking is limited
- Park only in the Senior lot, Ag Farm on Lemon or in the structure across the street

Grad Night May 28 Disneyland

- Students arrive at SHHS at **10:30 AM** for check-in
- Grad Night tickets will be distributed prior to boarding
- Photo ID required
- Buses depart at 11:00 AM
- Graduates may access both Disneyland Resort theme parks on the same day
- Students board buses at **1:00 AM** for return transfer



Graduate Check-In: 2:00 PM

- Report to the GYM on the South side of the Stadium
- Find your teacher in your assigned row

Attire

- Semi Formal Attire requested (dresses, suits, dress pants, button down shirt and tie)
- Spiked heels are not allowed (wedges are ok)
- No flip flops may be worn
- **All Cultural Regalia must be approved by Mrs. Bradley prior to Graduation**

Caps & Tassels

- The cap is to be worn square on the head (secure with bobby pins)
- The tassel is to hang on the RIGHT side of your head
- **Caps and gowns may not be personalized**
- Accessories such as medals, cords and stoles **must be approved by Mrs. Bradley prior to Graduation**

Personal Property

- No phones, flowers/leis, cameras, signs, or purses are permitted and will be collected upon entering
- You may bring in your car keys
- Leave all other personal items with family

Seating

- You will practice entrance and seating the day prior
- Remember your line and row from practice
- Inform your family which side of the stadium you are seated on so they may better see you (North side near Berkeley or South side near the Gym)

Photos

- A professional photographer will take a photo of each graduate on stage
- Proofs will be emailed within 5 days and will be available for purchase at <http://www.southcoastphotographic.com>

Parking

- Parking is limited
- Plan on heavy traffic and consider carpooling or being dropped off
- Park in the structure on Lemon or south of Chapman

Diploma & Recessional

- You will pick up your Diploma after leaving the field, in the Tennis Courts
- Arrange a meeting location with your family as you will not have your cell phone with you
- You are dismissed from Graduation after you pick up your Diploma
