

Freshman HEALTH SUMMER Course

Health is a 2 week online course that satisfies the Health graduation requirement. Students are required to attend in person on the first and last day of the term, In between the first and last term, students can either work from home or use the campus computer lab during summer school hours. Summer school runs Monday - Thursday 7:45am - 1:00pm.

Kindly note that priority for summer health course is given to current Sunny Hills students in grades 10-12. For incoming 9th-grade students, enrollment in health is on a request-only basis, and availability may be limited until subsequent years as a continuing Sunny Hills student. To request Health this summer, indicate your first and second choices for the term below. Please submit this card, along with the Freshman Course Selection Card, during the designated date and time at Registration Night. Students who are scheduled into the class will be contacted by parent email toward the end of May.
