Grad Nite @ Disneyland

May 31, 2019

- Students need to arrive at the school at 1:00 p.m. for check-in with a valid SHHS ID. <u>We will not wait for late students.</u>
- ALL participating students must ride the bus to and from Disneyland.
- Food and drinks are permitted on the bus, but are NOT ALLOWED in the park (including mints and factory sealed water bottles).
- Grad Nite starts at Disneyland and will continue at California Adventure at 10:00 p.m.
- Grad Nite ends at 2:00 a.m. Students will board buses at 2:30 a.m for the ride back to the school. Check in with your chaperone before you get on the bus.

What to Bring

Prohibited Items

- No alcoholic beverages/drugs/tobacco including vapes will be tolerated.

Dress Code

Conduct

Any student found to be under the influence of drugs/alcohol will not be allowed to get on the bus or attend Grad Nite. If anyone becomes a serious behavior problem, parents will be called and asked to pick-up the student. Refunds will not be given.

- Enrolled in 5 classes
- Pass Algebra 1 (or equivalent)
- Completed Grad Check completed with Counselor
- Completed Senior Survey
- Appropriate behavior and conduct at school and at school events between now and Graduation.

Important Information

- Arrive on time so we can finish on time. We are there until mastery is achieved.
- Practice may run until noon. Please plan accordingly and dress comfortably.
- Everyone will be assigned to a teacher. You will report to this teacher.
- Lists will be posted outside of room 1 on May 24.
- Those who do not attend will not be involved in the graduation ceremony.
- Parking is limited. Plan on heavy traffic; leave home early and carpool with other students.
- Park only in the senior lot, Ag farm on Lemon, or in the structure across the street.

Graduation Day Expectations

Graduation is a shared day of Dignity, Honor and Respect. Each graduate and their family deserves to have his/her name heard and each graduate deserves to be seen. Your dress and actions must be appropriate to the occasion. Anyone using poor judgment will be removed from the ceremony.

- Do not bring disruptive items to the ceremony (beach balls, etc.)
- Do not throw caps (or any items) during or after the ceremony.
- Remind your family to follow the rules so that everyone enjoys the day.
- NO noise makers, balloons, posters, signs, umbrellas, etc.

Attire

- Semi-Formal Attire (dresses, suits, dress pants, button down shirt and tie)
- NO spiked heels are not allowed on the turf (wedges ok)
- NO flip flops

- Caps & Tassels are to be worn square on the head (secure with bobby pins)
- Tassel (gold/black) worn on the RIGHT side
- You may not personalize your cap or gown
- All accessories (medals, cords & stoles) must be pre-approved

Graduate Check-In

- Arrive at 2:00 p.m. and report to the parking lot on the south side of stadium.
- Report to your teacher or assigned raquetball court.
- Do not bring any items with you other than your keys. NO flowers/leis, cell phones, cameras, signs, purses. ALL items, other than keys, will be collected upon entering.

Seating Information

Pay attention during practice how you enter and where your seat is to tell your family which side of the stadium they should enter and sit to see you better!

Parking

Additional parking is available in the city parking structure, south of Chapman on Lemon/Pomona. Daily parking permit of \$2.00 is required.

Handicap Accessibility

- Handicapped stadium seating available (+1 person).
- Handicap parking on east side of stadium. Follow signs.

Photos

- A professional photographer takes a photo of each graduate receiving a diploma.
- Proofs will be emailed and mailed within 5 days of the ceremony.
- Please visit <u>www.southcoastphotographic.com</u> to order.
- Parents, relatives, and friends must remain behind barriers and are NOT permitted inside the racquetball/tennis courts, on the field or in the tunnel.

Recessional (leaving the field)

At the end of the ceremony, graduates will report to the staff lounge to receive the actual diploma. During the ceremony you receive only the case. Please ask families to meet you in the quad. Pre-arrange a location as you won't have a cell phone. You are not dismissed until you have picked up your diploma.
