Taking an AP exam also lets you experience a college-level exam. Your work will be evaluated by college and university professors and AP teachers using

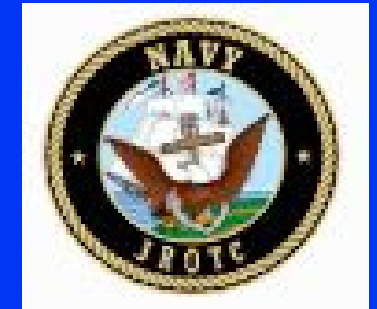
