Away camp is approximately \$475 per student. The total may change based on the number of students and required chaperones. The deposit of \$250.00 is due at the first parent meeting on Monday, May 4. The final payment will be due at the first summer practice on Monday, June 1.

Each member is expected to contribute their fair share to the team. The expected fair share contribution is approximately \$600, not including uniform and camp fees. If your family is experiencing financial hardship, please speak with the Advisor or Treasurer. Any information regarding hardship will be kept confidential on a need to know basis.

Please understand the contribution amount is a tentative number pending approval at the meeting in May. Once our team is set and we have finalized the number uniforms being purchased you will receive an update fair share contribution amount.
