Dear FJUHSD Staff Members, Students, and Parents/Guardians,

On December 1, 2020, we shared a letter regarding COVID-19 updates from the County. The purpose of this letter is to provide corrected and updated information.

In the letter sent yesterday, we stated "the County's adjusted Daily Case rate per 100,000 has remained in Tier 1 (Widespread). The other measurements outlined in California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy Test Positivity Rate and Health Equity Quartile Positivity Rate are currently classified in Tier 2 (Substantial)."

Yesterday afternoon the Orange County Health Care Agency updated their Dashboard. All of the County's measurements outlined in California's Blueprint for a Safer Economy, including the Adjusted Daily Case rate per 100,000, Test Positivity Rate, and Health Equity Quartile Positivity Rate, are now all classified in Tier 1 (Widespread).

Currently, the percentage of positive cases of COVID-19 in the Fullerton Joint Union High School District is 0.52%. This percentage is unique to our District schools and it represents confirmed, active COVID-19 cases among District students and staff on our campuses (in-person instruction and on-campus activities such as sports). The District Dashboard is updated daily.

Information from the County and the State is updated routinely and often. We appreciate your understanding as we work to communicate in a timely manner. For the most up to date information, please visit the <u>OCHCA Dashboard</u>. The OCHCA Dashboard is the resource that FJUHSD uses to report the information mentioned above.

As always, we will continue to monitor this situation closely and work collaboratively with public healthcare officials to receive guidance. We will keep our community informed as we have new information. The District is committed to communicating with students, parents, staff members, and the community in a timely manner.
