

2020-21 AP Exam Schedule

Hello Highlander families,

Attached is the 2020-21 La Habra High School AP Exam schedule for students who have registered for AP Exams. The schedule indicates the report times and location for each Exam. The AP exams are on campus, paper/pencil between **May 3rd -17th**. This follows <u>Administration 1</u> and is a traditional AP Exam administration window of on-campus testing before spring senior and underclassmen final exams and before important end of the school year activities. This will allow for fewer interferences with finals and the close of the school year. Please carefully read the very important information below regarding testing.

-Our testing window is between May 3rd -May 17th and exams are all paper/pencil on campus.

-All Exams are full length covering the full scope of course content.

-La Habra will not offer testing options after the last day of school (May 28th)

-AP Studio Art students will submit their portfolio on-line. There are no physical portfolios this year.

-Students will not be able to change test dates on their own.

-Students who choose not to test can receive a refund.

-All World Language Exams (Spanish, French, German, and Spanish Literature) are only offered paper/pencil on campus. No on-line options are available.

-Students will report to their designated testing location at the indicated time to complete check-in procedures.

-Students will need to bring a valid picture ID.

-Students should dress comfortably to anticipate changing temperatures.

-Students will need to adhere to all campus and CollegeBoard testing policies and procedures.

-If students/parents demonstrate a strong desire not to test paper/pencil on campus, they can request approval from the school to test digitally on-line/at home. However, paper/pencil on campus testing is our priority administration as it is targeted before student finals and important end of the year activities. Students approved for digital on-line/at home testing will have all their exams in this format. Student will be required to be cognizant of and stay current with CollegeBoards digital on-line/at home readiness steps. Keep in mind all World Language Exams are only Paper/Pencil on campus.

-Parents must request digital on-line/at home testing before **April 2nd** by emailing or calling Mr. Gallego at jgallego@fjuhsd.org or 562-266-5018. If we do not receive responses by this day, the Administration 1 paper/pencil on campus testing will be the only testing option.

-Digital on-line/at home testing is in Administration 2 between May 18-28.

-Please make special note that La Habra will only be proctoring the paper/pencil versions of these exams: Spanish, French, German Language, Spanish Literature, Calculus AB, Physics 1 and Statistics in (Administration 1).

2020-21 AP Digital On-Line/At Home Testing/Option

Important information regarding digital on-line/at home testing for this year.

-Digital on-line/at home exams are taken at home. La Habra staff do not proctor these.

-Student cannot mix and match digital on-line/at home with on campus paper/pencil exams.

-Digital on-line/at home are all full-length exams testing the same knowledge as on-campus paper/pencil exams.

-Digital on-line/at home exams are to be taken using a desktop or laptop computer (Windows, Mac or Chromebook) personal or school-provided device with a built in <u>working camera</u> and reliable internet connection. **No Smartphones**. Devices cannot be shared with other students after exam set up. -Device must be fully charged with a plugged in power supply.

-Will require typewritten responses. No handwritten or photographed work will be required or accepted. -Students will need the installed <u>AP Exam app</u> on the device used for exams and complete readiness steps. -Students will need to use their Collegeboard username/password to access the digital on-line/at home exam. -Beginning in April the AP Exam app will be available for download and students are highly recommended

to access the practice resources.

-Students taking the digital on-line/at home exams are required to have a <u>valid photo ID</u> on exam day. -Students taking digital on-line/at home exams are **Not allowed** to return to unanswered questions or move back and forth between unanswered questions.

-Includes security features to prevent students from cheating, impersonating and plagiarizing. -Students will need to check in 30 minutes before their official start time for each exam.

-Parents must request digital on-line/at home testing <u>before April 2nd</u> by emailing or calling Mr. Gallego at jgallego@fjuhsd.org or 562-266-5018. If we do not receive responses by this day, the Administration 1 paper/pencil on campus testing will be the only testing option. -Digital on-line/at home exams are synchronous/same time worldwide with start times at 9:00am or 1:00pm Pacific Standard Time.
