HS OUTREACH



Program Descriptions



Administration of Justice Pathway - Our program is designed for students who wish to pursue a career in the criminal justice system. We aim to assist students with their educational pathway and future career by providing a wide range of support services and experiences to ensure their successful completion of a degree, certificate, and/or transfer.

Cadena - The Cadena Cultural Center supports the core values of the college to elevate excellence in serving the needs of its diverse student population. The center strives to be an advocate and the nexus for the community to engage in conversations and action to enhance multiculturalism at Fullerton College.

CTE - Programs in Career Education (also known as Career and Technical Education or CTE) at Fullerton College are among the highest ranked two-year and short-term programs in the country. CTE is about preparing students for careers.

DSS - The Disability Support Services (DSS) office at Fullerton College advocates the integration of qualified students with disabilities into the mainstream of Fullerton College's programs and services. DSS is committed to the provision of support services and/or educational accommodations to qualified students with disabilities.

EOPS - The Extended Opportunity Program & Services (EOPS) is dedicated to recruit and successfully retain college students of educationally and socioeconomically disadvantaged backgrounds. The primary purpose of the EOPS program is to prepare students to transfer to a four-year university, complete an associate degree or earn a vocational certificate in order to acquire desirable career-related skills to obtain rewarding employment as a result of their educational experience.

Grads to Be - The Grads to Be Program provides a variety of services and resources for undocumented students at Fullerton College. The program's focus is on student's overall wellness as a means to facilitate and enhance their educational experience at Fullerton College and complete their educational goals on a timely basis.

Honors - The Fullerton College Honors Program is designed to encourage talent and ability in highly motivated students as they begin their academic studies and prepare to transfer to a college or university. Students who complete the Honors Program and meet all major transfer requirements will have priority consideration for admission to certain transfer institutions.

LGBTQIA+ - Reach out if you are in need of resources, guidance, connection, or a little queer gossip. Your safety and experience on campus (in person or online) are important! Don't hesitate to reach out if you are feeling lost, unheard, or just want to manifest an event or resource.

Promise - The Promise Program provides 2 years of free tuition to first-time college students. We want to help students with the cost of college by covering the enrollment and health fees through the North Orange Promise Fee Waiver. The program provides wrap around services to first-time and continuing Promise students. There is no income requirement, just to be a first-time college student and a California Resident.

Puente - Puente is a program designed to assist students in transferring to universities. The program consists of English, Counseling, and mentoring components with reading and writing assignments focusing on the Latino/Chicano experience. Activities such as field trips and guest speakers are used to enrich students' educational, cultural, and social opportunities.

STEM - STEM at Fullerton College is comprised of our Natural Sciences, Mathematics/Computer Science, and Counseling Departments' support for you in any major/career path that is related to Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics.

UMOJA - Umoja, (a Kiswahili word meaning unity) is a community and critical resource dedicated to enhancing the cultural and educational experiences of Black/African American and other students. We believe that when the voices and histories of students are deliberately and intentionally recognized, the opportunity for self-efficacy emerges and a foundation is formed for academic success. Umoja actively serves and promotes student success for all students through a curriculum and pedagogy responsive to the legacy of the African and African American Diasporas.

Information & Instructions

The Financial Aid Office is currently closed for in-person services, including in-person assistance with completing financial aid applications – Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and California Dream Act Application (CADAA). Instead, we will be providing assistance via Zoom with step-by-step process in completing a FAFSA or CADAA application. The workshops will only be for guidance on completing a 2022-2023 FAFSA or CADAA. If you need more in-depth assistance that requires us to look into your specific account, please contact your assigned Financial Aid Technician via email, text message, or phone. A list of Financial Aid Technicians and alpha breakdown can be found on the Financial Aid Office website <https://financialaid.fullcoll.edu/#contact>. You may also call our front desk for general financial aid questions.

Come Prepared

The following documents are needed (both you and your parents, if Dependent) in order to complete the application online:

- Social Security Card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (If applicable)
- FSA ID or User ID and Password to complete your application
- Driver's License/State Identification Card (If applicable)
- Your Permanent Resident Card (if you are not a U.S. Citizen) (If applicable)
- Both your and your parent's 2020 Federal income tax return and/or W2 form(s) (include parent's tax information if dependent) (If applicable)
- Parent's Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) (If applicable)
- Parent's full name, date of birth and date of marital status (if dependent)



NOTE: If you do not have the required documents listed above, the Financial Aid Technician will only be able to provide general information about the financial aid process. Completion of financial aid documentation will not occur without required documents.
