It is my pleasure to welcome you and your student to the 2025–2026 school year at La Habra High School! This past year was filled with remarkable accomplishments across academics, the arts, and athletics—testaments to the dedication of our students, staff, and families.

In the arts, our students continued to shine on stage and in competition. Our award-winning marching band and color guard captivated audiences with their field show *Imagine*, finishing in the Top 6 in the state.

In athletics, 21 of our 24 athletic programs advanced to the CIF playoffs. Football, Boys' water polo, baseball, and softball secured league titles. Our athletes were also part of our recent historic runs with the 2023 CIF Cheer Championship and the 2024 CIF Boys Basketball Championship. With this athletic excellence, 18 Highlanders from the Class of 2025 earned athletic scholarships to colleges and universities across the country.

We are especially honored to share that 11 graduates committed to serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. Their courage and selfless dedication to protecting our nation embody the very best of our Highlander spirit.

In the classroom, our tradition of excellence continued as we celebrated another year of outstanding instruction. For the third consecutive year—and the fifth time in the past eight—La Habra High School is home to the FJUHSD Teacher of the Year. This year, we proudly honored Mrs. Cardenas, who joins a distinguished group of past recipients

We introduced in-school Dual Enrollment with Fullerton College and Cypress College for English, US History, and Psychology, resulting in 99% of students (209 classes) who took those courses earning college credit, with 80% earning an A or a B. In the last four years, we have seen a 22% increase in our Highlanders passing AP tests, the most significant improvement in the District. This year, we will offer the first year of the AP Capstone Program, bringing additional competitive academic opportunities for all our students.

As we begin a new year, I encourage all parents and guardians to stay actively involved in our school community through the PTA, booster clubs, and other volunteer opportunities. Your partnership plays a critical role in our students' success, and we value the strong connection between home and school.

On behalf of the entire faculty and staff, thank you for being part of the La Habra High School community. We are excited to welcome you back and are committed to meeting the needs of every Highlander. We look forward to the journey ahead and the new successes this year will bring.
