

Attention Students taking 2019 AP Exams

What to Bring to the Exam

- Your AP Student Pack (You will receive this at your first AP test)
- A valid photo I.D. (Troy Student ID or government-issued photo ID)
- Pens with black or dark blue ink (in a clear Ziploc bag only)
- Several sharpened #2 pencils with erasers (in a clear Ziploc bag only)
- A watch that does not have internet access, does not beep, and does not have an alarm.
- Up to two approved calculators with the necessary capabilities for AP Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics exams only. Biology requires a four-function calculator with square root. Students can visit apstudents.org/courses and click on the link for their course for the specific calculator policy.
- A ruler or straightedge only if you're taking an AP Physics Exam. Protractors are not allowed.
- Your College Board SSD Accommodations Letter if you are taking an exam with pre-approved testing accommodations.

**NOTE: NO CELL PHONES, BACKPACKS
OR BAGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE
TESTING ROOM.**

What NOT to Bring to the Exam:

- **Electronic equipment (phones, smartwatches or wearable technology of any kind, laptop, tablet computers, Bluetooth devices, portable listening or recording devices--MP3 player, iPod, etc.-- cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the internet, separate timers of any type, and any other electronic or communication devices) are prohibited in the exam room and break areas. School-owned recording devices and equipment are allowed only for the AP French, AP Spanish Language and the AP Music Theory Exam.**
- **Pencil cases**
- **Books, compasses, protractors, mechanical pencils, No. 3 pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or colored pencils**
- **Rulers, straightedges and protractors (except as previously noted)**
- **Scratch paper (will be provided when designated by College Board)**
- **Computers or calculators (except as previously noted)**
- **Reference guides, keyboard maps or other typing instructions**
- **Watches that beep or have an alarm**
- **Food or drink**
- **Ear plugs**
- **Hats or hooded jackets, clothing with subject-related information**
- **Clipboards**

NOTE: CELL PHONES ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE TESTING ROOM, SO PLEASE DO NOT BRING THEM. IF PHONES ARE DISCOVERED IN THE EXAM ROOM, THEY WILL BE CONFISCATED AND GIVEN TO ADMINISTRATION. (We will not be held liable for lost phones.) Failure to follow these rules will lead to cancellation of your AP examination!
