Course Title: Advanced Placement (AP) Art

Course Prerequisites: Refer To Registration Presentation

Course Description:

Students will complete a portfolio of 24 art pieces that will be evaluated by The College Board. The Portfolio will be consisting of art pieces which will include Quality, Concentration and Breadth. Students may use art pieces from previous art courses or work done on their own.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

- Students should know the Art Elements and Principles. Students should have knowledge and be able and willing to expand on their Craftsmanship, Creativity and Concept in their artwork.

Workload Expectations for this course (list typical amount of homework, projects, presentations, papers, etc.):

- Projects are completed in class. Some outside artwork may take place, depending on how many projects the student has completed. Projects are individual and group based and may involve using mediums such as Oil Paint, Acrylic Paint, Watercolor, Graphite, Charcoal and Pastels.
