Description:

Senior Internship requires that the student exhibits a high degree of personal responsibility, work independently, and demonstrate self-initiative. Senior Internship is a model School-to-Career program allowing senior students a hands-on experience and opportunity to work with a professional in the occupational field of the student's choice. Senior Internship requires that the student locate an internship within the area of their career interests and complete a total of 150 hours. Reflection upon their experiences is conducted through a final presentation to the school/community summarizing their time spent in business/industry.
