Course Title: Media Concepts

Course Description:

This course is designed to prepare students for the media pathway classes which include Media Concepts Honors, Broadcast Journalism and Film. There are six main concepts covered:

- 1. Design elements- includes color theory, font, layout
- 2. Web Pages- use of Adobe Spark

- 6. Social Media the basics of communication with social media
