Course Title: Media Concepts

Course Prerequisites: Refer to Registration Presentation

Course Description:

This course is designed to prepare students for the media pathway classes which include Media Concepts Honors, Broadcast Journalism and Film. There are six main concepts covered:

1. Design elements- includes color theory, font, layout
2. Web Pages- use of Adobe Spark
3. Photography and photo basics with mobile devices,
4. Audio- lessons with recording audio and sound editing with mobile devices.
5. Video-lessons in using mobile device for filming and editing
6. Social Media - the basics of communication with social media

During each of the six concepts covered students will focus on storytelling.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:

Students need only to be hard working self-starters who are curious and creative.

Students will be expected to work diligently during class. Outside of class time is rarely more than 2 hours per week.
