Course Title: World History

Course Description: This history/social science course examines the major turning points of the modern world from approximately 1750 to the present. Components of this class include: Historical Linkage, the French Revolution, the Industrial Revolution, the Rise of Imperialism and Colonialism, World War I, Totalitarianism, World War II and Nationalism. Students should develop an understanding of the historic as well as contemporary geographic, social, political and economic consequences of the various areas and problems they review.

Students entering this course should already have a mastery of the following concepts and possess the following skills:
